Additionally, efforts to trace his father failed as Dunavant Ltd declined having any employee by his father's name. However, they mentioned that his father might have worked at the company as a casual worker.

It was then concluded that some relations of his might have dumped him on the street, since he does not know much of what transpired and has given three different names of his mother.

Moses was later transferred to Lifenet Children's Rescue Mission on June 6, 2004. He started school in 2005 and is now in grade two at Ng'ombe Basic School.

Moses' academic performance has improved from being one of the least in class to one of those on top of the class list. He always says he wants to be the president of Zambia in future.
